

Hospital Continues Clean Up and Rebuilding



February, 2008 - Mountain View, Ark – Crews are making repairs and preparations for temporary facilities at Stone County Medical Center. Restoration experts are onsite to assist with clean up efforts.

The Emergency Department is open for patient care from the Surgery Department of the hospital. Ancillary services (pharmacy, laboratory, respiratory and x-ray) are operational.

A modular medical facility is being installed on the north side of the hospital campus. The Emergency Department and ancillary services will be relocated to the modular building allowing the surgery department to reopen. The building will also provide clinic office space for Dr. Ron Simpson, Dr. Michelle Bishop, Dr. Anandaraj “Andy” Subramaniam and Dr. Charles Varela. The building is being delivered and should be operational in 7 to 14 days. Temporary modular buildings for support services are also being installed.

“We are working to restore inpatient care as soon as possible,” said Karen Craft, SCMC Administrator. “The modular building provides the space we need to continue to provide patient care during the rebuilding process.”
