The new facility will include; Midway Medical Clinic, office of Dr. Tim Young, Hardy Medical Clinic, office of Dr. Don Lamoureux, WRMC Urgent Care Clinic, WRMC Specialty and Endoscopy Clinic, WRMC Progressive Home Care and WRMC Pros –

Physical, Occupational and Speech Therapy. Dr. Sra and Dr. Taylor will continue their private medical practice in its current location.

The medical office complex will provide comprehensive outpatient services. In addition to physician office space and rehabilitation therapies, medical services include mammography, bone densitometry, x-ray laboratory and an operating room for outpatient surgical procedures and endoscopy. Construction will begin immediately and is scheduled to be completed in 12-14 months.
